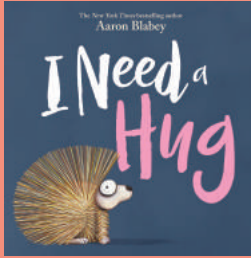

### I Need a Hug

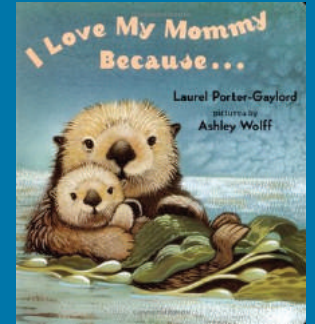

By: Laurel Porter-Gaylord

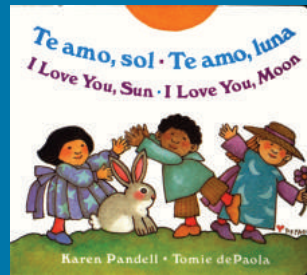
"I love my mommy because she gives me great big hugs." Mothers show love to their children in many ways. In this colorful book, young children will learn all about different animals and how they express love for each other.



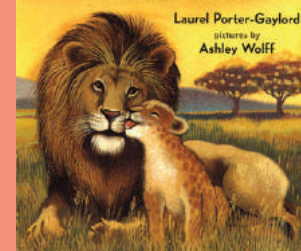
### I Love You, Sun / I Love You, Moon
