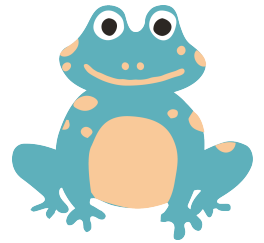

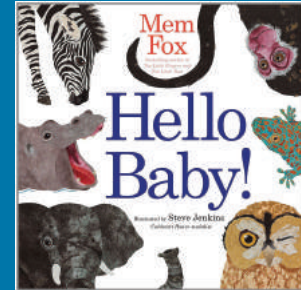
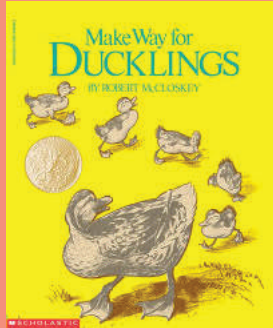

From Head to Toe

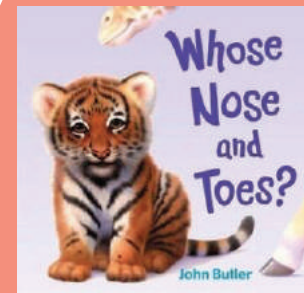
By: Eric Carle

By: John Butler



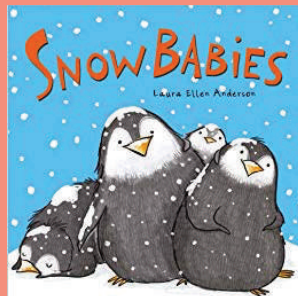
This interactive board book introduces baby animals and their different noses and feet.
