Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?

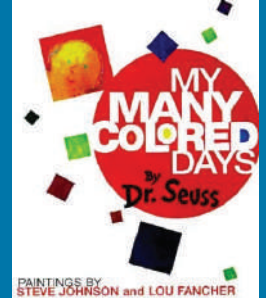

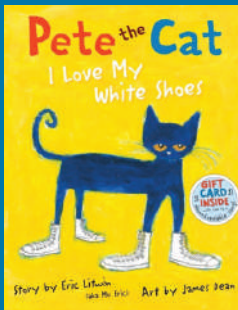
Children will love this simple rhyming text and guessing what color and animal will come next.

By: Dr. Seuss



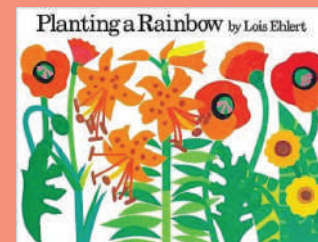
This beautifully illustrated book helps children identify their feelings as well as colors.

Planting A Rainbow

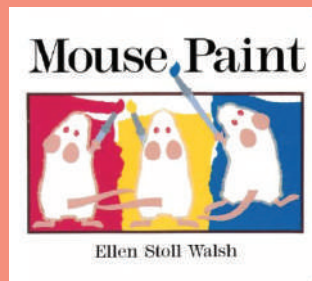
By: Lois Ehlert
