#DYK? Understanding shapes is one of the early math concepts that can prepare your child for later success in school.

Have a shape scavenger hunt with your child! Together, you can search for car tires (circles), windows (rectangles), and stop signs (hexagons).

When you make lunch, ask your child, “Would you like your sandwich cut in four triangles or four squares?”

Playing with blocks can help your baby learn about shapes and early engineering concepts! What does your baby like building when she plays with blocks?
