

Listen to the Rain


Rookie Toddler by Scholastic

By: Cathryn Falwell



By: Eric Carle


Little Cloud likes to change into the things he sees in the sky, land and sea. This is a great book to read with children and then go outside and look for familiar shapes in clouds.
