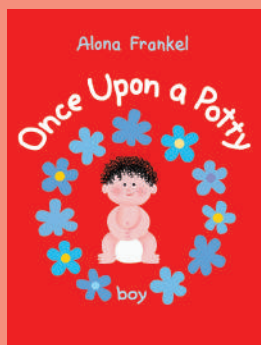

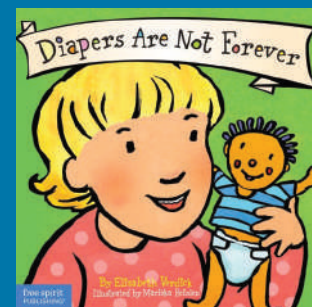
This book teaches boys how to use the potty! Your little one will learn about what it means to transition from a diaper to a potty, including all the happy accidents and celebrations along the way!

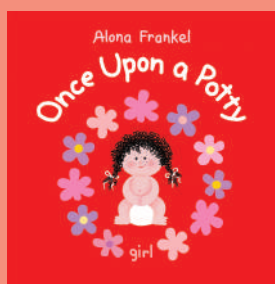

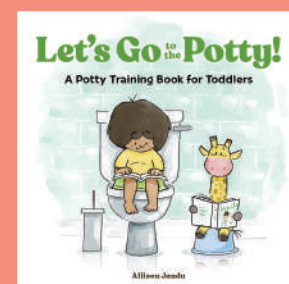
